Position Reports To:

Lift Operations Manager

Essential Functions:

- Assist all passengers in the safe loading and unloading of the ski lift.
- Provide instruction and superior customer service by interacting and talking to all lift passengers.
- Slow chairs to ensure the comfort and safety of passengers loading and unloading the lift.
- Slow or stop the lift as necessary to ensure passenger safety.
- Maintain load and unload ramps and areas around all lift stations by shoveling and/or raking snow.
- Ensure all chairs are clear of snow, ice, and/or grease before loading passengers.
- Identify potential hazards and report them immediately.
- Be familiar with all policies, procedures and rules regarding operating and riding a ski lift and ensure that these are followed by other staff and customers.
- Implement emergency procedures, including contacting Ski Patrol.
- Perform daily pre-operation inspections and post-operation shutdown procedures.
- Assist in evacuation of a disabled lift if needed.
- Check to ensure every skier or snowboarder has a valid day ticket or season pass each time before boarding the lift.
- Answer guest questions by being familiar with White Pine's layout, products and services, or by asking someone who can answer the guest's questions.
- Maintain cleanliness of lift shacks and work area, remove trash when necessary.
- Other lift operations duties as assigned.

Basic Requirements:

- No experience necessary, we train all lift operators (even returnees).
- Must be physically capable of assisting customers while loading lifts, monitoring the unloading of lifts, shoveling snow, grooming load/unload ramps, making quick decisions, and assisting with lift maintenance if needed.
- Must be able to work in cold and often inclement conditions.
- No current physical limitations.
- Must work well with others and interact genuinely with guests.
- Job may require long periods of time standing outside will be required.
- **In accordance with Wyoming State Law, Lift Operators must be at least 18 years of age.**



Preferred Experience & Skills:

- Prior experience, and some mechanical ability are preferred, though not required.
- Skiing or Snowboarding experience also preferred, though not required.
- White Pine Resort will provide a uniform jacket and equipment (if employee does not have their own ski/board equipment).
- Employee will be responsible for providing their own basic winter clothing (black snow pants, gloves, warm base layers, hat/beanie, etc.).

White Pine Resort is an Equal Opportunity Employer, Operating under USFS Special Use Permit in the Bridger-Teton National Forest. Work is usually Fridays thru Mondays from the start of ski season (sometime between late November and early December depending on the snow) to the end of March at White Pine Ski Resort, 10 miles from the town of Pinedale, Wyoming. Reliable winter transportation is required! A high level of responsibility and reliability are also required, and all employees of White Pine Resort must pass a pre-employment background check.
